Recycled content: 100% Postindustrial waste

3. Compliance with Regulatory Requirements

According to the relevant confirmation from our supplier(s) and based on current information, the material in question does not contain any substances listed in Annex XIV of the REACH Regulation that are subject to notification under Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH).

This statement is based on the SVHC Candidate List as of 4 February 2026.

The material in question does not contain the substances of concern—lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium—or contains them in concentrations below the limit of 100 mg/kg, in accordance with Packaging Regulation 2025/40.

The material in question is not intended for use as food or pharmaceutical packaging. Therefore, an assessment of the PFAS limit values in accordance with the PPWR is not required.

4. Recyclability (Assessment)
